

Romanian EdTech Kinderpedia shortlisted for the Global EdTech Prize 2026

The AI-powered school management and communication platform is recognised globally for helping schools build more connected, inclusive communities around every child

Bucharest, Romania, August 13, 2026: [Kinderpedia](https://www.kinderpedia.co), the Romanian-built AI-powered school management and communication platform, has been selected for the **Global EdTech Prize 2026** shortlist, part of an international recognition initiative founded by **T4 Education** with the support of **Owl Ventures** and **Digital Promise**.

The Global EdTech Prize recognises trailblazing solutions that are driving change and grappling with some of the most crucial challenges in today's classrooms. The nomination places Kinderpedia within a global cohort of EdTech platforms focused on major education priorities, including literacy and language development, personalised learning and assessment, teacher capacity, school operations, wellbeing, STEM and AI readiness, access and inclusion, and smoother transitions into the world of work.

For Kinderpedia, this nomination represents a validation of a broader shift in education: schools need technology that does more than digitise tasks. They need secure, intelligent and human-centred systems that help the adults around each child work better together.

Built in Romania and trusted by more than 2,000 education institutions in 40+ countries, Kinderpedia turns fragmented school administration and one-way parent messaging into inclusive, connected learning communities. It gives teachers back time, offers school leaders better visibility and empowers families to play a more meaningful role in children's education.

Kinderpedia supports K-12 schools, preschools, nurseries and childcare centres through one secure, cloud-based ecosystem that connects school management, communication, attendance, classroom activity, student progress, reporting, finance, wellbeing, collaboration and admissions.

Through its web and mobile platforms, Kinderpedia helps educators share real-time updates, track learning progress, manage classroom workflows, communicate with families, streamline invoicing and payments, and make better use of school data. For families, it creates clearer access to school life and a more consistent connection to the child's learning journey.

The platform includes practical AI capabilities designed specifically for school communities. These tools help educators communicate more clearly, document student progress faster, identify patterns earlier and reduce repetitive administrative work, while keeping professional judgement and human relationships at the centre of education.

Kinderpedia was built around a simple idea: children learn and grow better when the adults around them are connected, informed and able to work together. In diverse school communities, this means helping every family feel seen, included and closer to their child's learning journey.

For us, technology is not only about efficiency. It is about equity, trust and participation. When communication becomes clearer and learning becomes more visible, more families can engage meaningfully with the school, and that is where digital tools can have real impact."

The prize is awarded in three categories: Majors, Start-Ups and Non-Profits, with winners announced live at the World Schools Summit in London on 17 January 2027. The next stage of the Global EdTech Prize will be announced in September, when finalists will be invited to the World Schools Summit to showcase their work before an Expert Panel made up of leading figures in technology and education, including investors and policymakers from around the world.
